In 1930, eleven-year-old orphan Hurricane McAdams has more bad-school-luck than even David Copperfield in her little one room schoolhouse high on the cliffs overlooking the Mighty Atlantic where her teacher – Miss Witherspoon -- doesn't think being quiet is a positive attribute.


But Hurricane likes this side of herself very much – it's how she knows her favorite seagull wants to race, how she can hear her yellow front door whispering how happy it is to see her after another terrible day at school, and how she knows what her old dog Brody-Bear is thinking, just by looking in his eyes. You have to listen with your whole heart to hear the things the world is trying to tell you, and be very still on the inside.

When her older sister is sent to a tuberculosis sanatorium in the mountains, Hurricane is pulled away from her home and the dog she loves so much. She is taken in by her forthright, Latin-quoting Great Aunt Claire to a fancy house in the city where everything matches and portraits of the ancestors hang from all the walls and where she is completely lost.

But as she learns to play chess, secretly adopts a stray cat as lonely as she, befriends an "unsuitable" fish peddler boy, and learns to bake the most amazing cakes with a WWI soldier suffering shellshock, Hurricane discovers another side to herself – a strength that requires her to stand up and unleash everything she's been holding back if she's going to rescue her dog and bring her sister home again to their house wrapped in driftwood, overlooking the sea.
