



Little cloud Rae desperately wants to be big. An older cloud explains to her how to achieve that. Rae moves through the country, takes in water from lakes, rivers, and the morning dew, and finds a friend in a flower. Rae grows and grows until she has become too full and pours down on the land as welcome rain.

At first, Rae seems light and transparent, as if dabbed into the sky. By accompanying her growth, we come to understand the cycle of cloud formation and rain. Mexican author Ixtzel Arreola has succeeded in wrapping this natural phenomenon in a child-friendly, engaging story. Martina Liebig's images celebrate the drama of South American landscapes.

#### Vitali Konstantinov

was born in Ukraine and studied architecture, graphics, painting, and art history. For more than 20 years he has been writing and illustrating books, which have been published in 40 countries. In 2020 he was nominated for the German Youth Literature Prize. Vitali Konstantinov lives in Marburg, Germany, where he works as a freelance illustrator and author.
