CHANTAL: "I'm sorry, he's not himself when he doesn't get his seven meals a day at his regular times . (thinks) Well, actually, he's too much himself, when he doesn't."

QUESTION: "Kurt, you seem to find everything about unicorns annoying. So, what's your take on unicornthemed birthday parties? Are they your idea of a nightmare or just another eye-roll-worthy event?"
