Tiger and Bear were originally created by the renowned artist Janosch (Horst Eckert). During his early career he was a student of the painter Paul Klee. In 1960 he published his first children's book and has been a painter, rhyme-maker, author of children's books, picture books and novels, the creator of stories and characters. He was awarded the Germany Youth Literature Prize. Today he lives in a sunny paradise high in the mountains of Tenerife. The characters he developed have been evolved by Florian Fickel, author of many radio plays, and Johanna Seipelt.

Janosch's classic "The Trip to Panama" in which Tiger, Bear and Tiger Duck had their first appearance, has sold over 10. million copies world wide and Janosch's books have been translated into over 100 languages.
